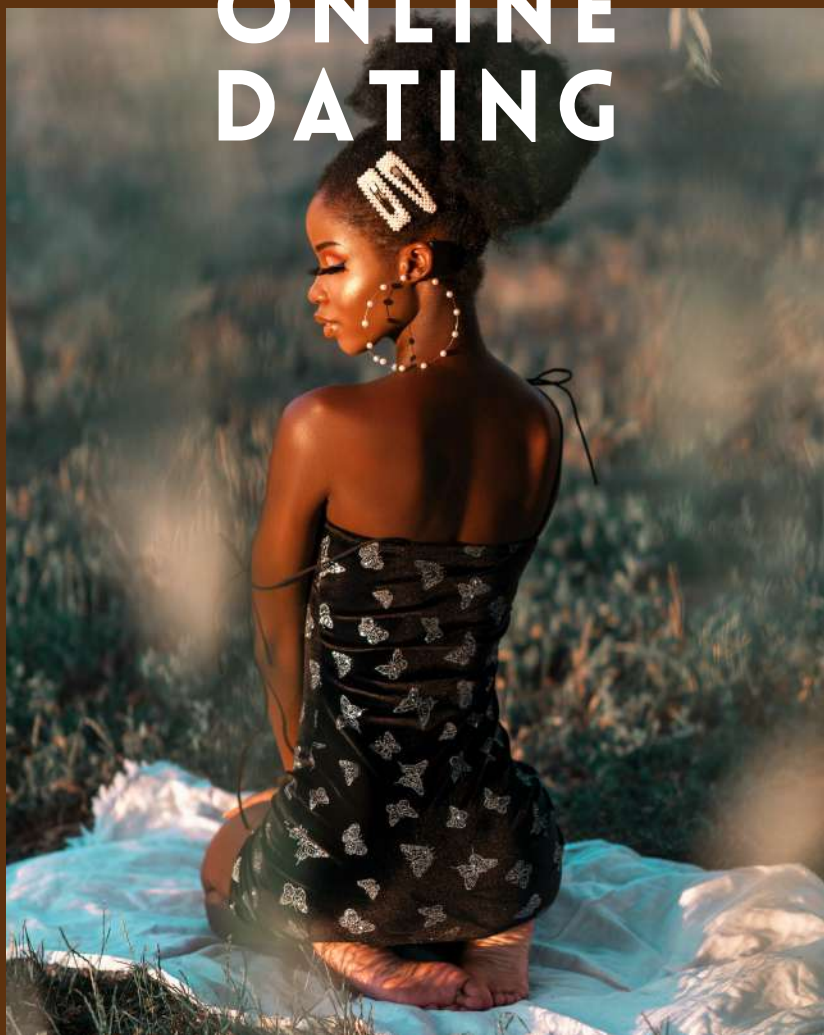

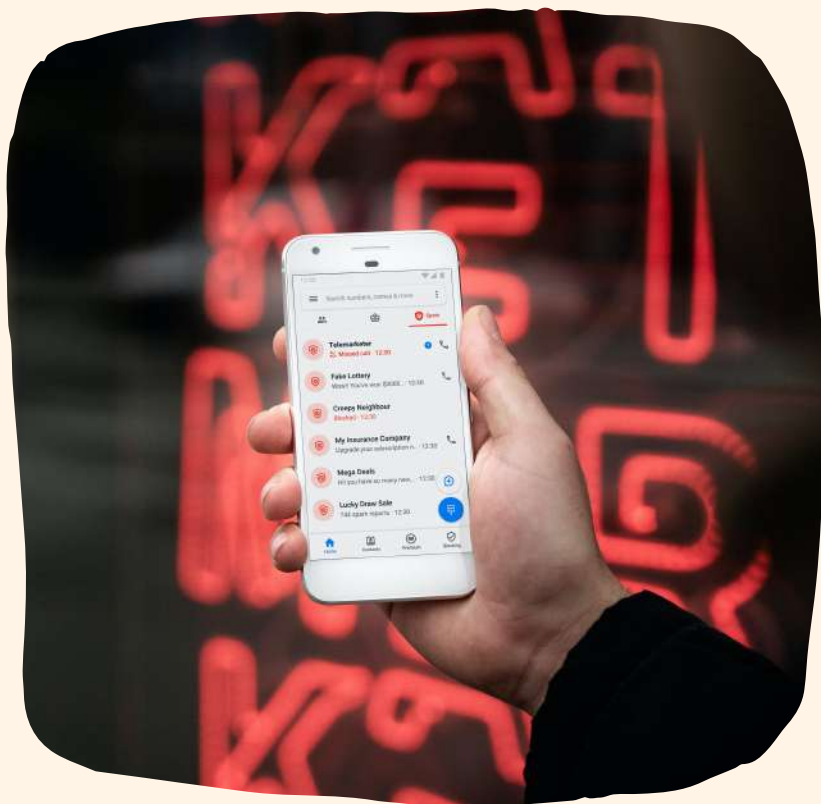
For you to breeze through this evaluation, your conversation must demonstrate to her that you're honest and chivalrous. Listen to her as she speaks and respect her opinions at the very same.
